### **Biographical/Administrative History**

Thomas Foley was born in Baltimore of immigrant Irish parents on March 6, 1822. A graduate with the degree of A.B. from St. Mary's College, Baltimore, at the age of 18, he was ordained a priest at 24 from St. Mary's Seminary of Baltimore. He was pastor for 20 years at Baltimore Cathedral and, in turn, Chancellor, Vicar-General, and Administrator of the Archdiocese of Baltimore.

In November of 1869, Foley was appointed Coadjutor-bishop and Administrator of the Diocese of Chicago. He was consecrated bishop of February 27, 1870 in the Cathedral of Baltimore. Within one year of his appointment, Foley founded fifteen parishes, a hospital, and several schools and orphanages.

Bishop Foley was in Champaign, Illinois, to administer confirmation when, on October 8-9, 1871, the Chicago Fire destroyed most of the churches, schools, and other institutions of the Diocese. Foley quickly began the work of reconstruction and he secured funds throughout the East to purchase supplies, clothing, and food. The churches and schools were quickly rebuilt and when Holy Name Church was rebuilt in 1875, it was designated the Cathedral of the Diocese.

Bishop Foley invited the Franciscans, Vincentians, Servites, Viatorians, and Resurrectionists to establish parishes and schools. At his request, the Diocese of Peoria was established in 1877 to secure Catholics in central Illinois. After nine years as Bishop and administrator of Chicago, Foley died on February 19, 1879.
